

ADMISSION POLICIES

ADMISSIONS

- Minimum age to enroll is 7 to 13 yrs. Children ages 5-6 yrs are enrolled in Phulwari (pre K) class.
- Enrollment opens once a year in March through June. The late registration fee is \$25 per child. School session begins in September and ends in May/June.
- By enrolling your child, he/she is expected to participate in the full program. To keep academic standards high and for a well-rounded development of our children, we do not offer an ala-carte program for any child. If your child is 18 yrs or above, they are allowed to take any number of classes they choose. They are also welcome to work and earn community service hours.
- If a child has missed a year of school, a placement test is mandatory.
- Class size is 5 – 20 students. If classes are full, your child will be placed in the waiting list for the current/next year.
- If there are open vacancies in higher level class, new students can be placed with an entrance test.
- School hours are from 10:00 am to 1:30 pm. Phulwari class runs from 10:00am to 12:30 pm.
- Annual donation is \$200 per child. Cost of books is additional.
- Each family donates for no more than two children. Enrollment for any additional child is free. If you have a financial difficulty; please contact **GNCA** admissions.

- Kirtan lessons; {30 hrs, all instruments provided by **GNCA**},
- Sikh History and Gurbani Lessons {30 hrs all material provided}

- Bhangra lessons, Minimum of 10 weeks for preparation for the Annual Cultural Program participation.
- Participation in the Annual Cultural Program. This includes: awards and certificates, community service hours for the participants, meals and snacks during extra practices, and representation of **GNCA**.
- Participation in the Annual Gurburab Program. This includes: awards and certificates, community service hours for the participants. {Turbans and Chunni's may be provided by **GNCA**} Meals and snacks during extra practices, and representation of **GNCA**.
- Academic achievement awards.
- Annual year end party or picnic.
