GNCA DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Authority for discipline rests only with the **GNCA** disciplinary committee. This committee is formed of one member of the Board, a class teacher, and the school director. The discipline committee process is based on honesty and telling the truth. The response to violation is intended to be just and best for the school and the student.

DISCIPLINARY REPONSE SYSTEM

<u>Minor violation</u>: Transgressions such as tardiness, absence, incompletion of assignment, inappropriate behavior, littering, and use of unapproved electronic devices will be considered as minor violation. Parent and student will be notified via DC slip and student will be given a warning.

<u>Moderate violation</u>: Destructive behavior, vandalism of property, insubordination, inappropriate gestures, derogatory remarks, disruptive behavior and other similar conduct will be considered as moderate violation. Any continued minor violation after receiving a warning is considered as moderate violation. The student and parent will meet with the **GNCA** DC. Suspension is a possibility.

<u>Major Violation</u>: Harassment of any kind; harming anyone, student or teacher in physical or verbal fashion; and substance abuse on or off campus. Any continued moderate violation after receiving a suspension is considered as major violation. The student and parent will meet with the GNCA DC. Expulsion is the automatic consequence. The result of the meeting will be announced to the community at the GNCA assembly. The final disciplinary decision rests with the DC who has the authority to impose disciplinary action.
