- Guru Gobind Singh ji.

2. What was the life span of Guru Gobind Singh Ji, and his Gurgadi years?

- Birth –12/22/1666 at Patna, Bihar
- Jotijot – 10/07/1708 (he was 42yrs old)
- Guruship - 1675 to 1708 (From age 9 for 33years)

- Father: Guru TegBahadur Ji, The ninth Guru
- Mother: Mata Gujri ji
- Wife: Mata Jito a.k.a Mata Sundari
- Son: Ajit Singh, Jujhar Singh, Zorawar Singh, Fateh Singh

4. What was Guru Gobind Singh ji's, notable contribution to Sikhi?

- He nominated Sri Guru Granth Saheb ji as the next perpetual Guru of the Sikhs.
- He is the creator of Khalsa Panth

5. How many of Guru Gobind Singh Ji's compositions are included in the Guru Granth Sahib Ji?

None. Guru Gobind Singh Ji's compositions are part of Dasam Granth- Jaap Sahib, Akal Ustad, Chandi di Var, Shabad Hazarey, Sawayyw (33 Stanzas), Kahlsa Mehma etc. Dasam Granth is almost the number of pages as Guru Granth Sahib ji, 1428. Dasam Granth was compiled by Bhai Nand Lal ji, a devoted disciple of Guru Gobind Singh Ji, after Guru ji had passed away to heavenly abode.

6. Which Gurdawara is notably related to Guru Gobind Singh Ji?

- Harmandir Saheb, Patna- Birth place of Guru Gobind Singh Ji.
- Kesgarh Saheb- Khalsa Panth was created here
- Damdama Saheb- Guru Gobind Singh ji got the full path of Guru Granth Saheb written here.
- Hazur Sahib- Guru Gobind Singh ji became joti jot here
